This Term

We will be focusing on mathematical development within Pre-School. We will be promoting mathematical language, knowledge and discussion in all areas of the room, activities and outdoor play. We will be reinventing our communication spaces both indoor and outdoor to encourage conversation, sequencing and other mathematical language. We will be promoting number language in everyday routines as well as fine motor skills as we give children the opportunity to choose their snack/favourite food and outdoor toys. We will be doing lots of number games and songs such as 'What time is it Mr Wolf?' and '5 little speckled frogs' inside and outside and incorporating these into our activities and play. We will be promoting mathematical development through the children's interests which this term include: Fairies, Pirates, 'Our achievements,' Sports Week and Schools.

Lots of children will be visiting their new school's over the next few weeks, in preparation for September. We will be supporting these children by providing a transition pack before their visit, these packs are to share with your child at home and introduce them to their school, classroom and teachers.
