### Tiger room

We have new larger coat peg name labels to support the children to recognise their name, when hanging up their coat. Time will be spent when writing names and introducing children at circle time to recognise their name and the initial letter/ letter sound.

### Jungle room

We have altered the room layout to create a more structured play area, whilst still offering the same activities.

We are introducing 'mark making' activities at the beginning of each session. Parents/carers can join their child to find their name and have a go at making marks or writing their name. A member of staff will be in this area to encourage and support the children to take part in this activity.

### All children

We will be encouraging children to share their achievements, whether this be a 'wow' moment from home, a creation they have made or a certificate they have received from a sport etc. This can be put on our sharing table/board and will be shared with their friends at the end of the session.

Please encourage your child to bring in their favourite book from home, which we will share over the upcoming weeks. We will use the stories and children's interest in them to feed into the activities we provide for the children.

All children have access to a drink of water/milk at all times during the session, during this time we will be supporting children to drink from a cup. We ask parents/carers to provide a drink of their choosing (non fizzy) for lunchtime only.
